Student Health Services (SHS) is an ambulatory-care facility providing screening and evaluations by nurses; examinations and treatment by primary care physicians, ARNP's, and PA's; laboratory services; a Health Promotion Department; and specialty clinics in Antigen and Gynecology. SHS is a walk-in clinic with a brief-stay day infirmary. SHS had about 31,200 patient visits in academic year 2006/07.

A Human Services Practitioner provides direct intervention, action research, training, and consultative services for/to agencies, families, and individuals with various social services programs, developmental disabilities and/or special needs. This position requires a qualified human services professional who will provide direct assistance to clients, or serve as case manager to coordinate the delivery of services to clients.
